

## **E. Lindsey Maxwell II, Esq.**



Lindsey grew up in Montclair, N.J. and graduated from the University of Pittsburgh with a B.A. in Legal Studies. He went on to receive his J.D. from the University Of Akron.

Mr. Maxwell served as a legislative aide in the New Jersey state legislature before entering into the private practice of law in Washington, D.C. at Beins, Axelrod & Kraft. He later became a partner at the Perennial Law Group, a nationally-recognized leader in sports management and representation. While there, he represented the NBA Referees Association, the Major League Baseball Umpires Association and dozens of NFL and NBA athletes, authors, musicians and television personalities.

He later accepted a partnership with the prestigious Bailey Law Group focusing his practice on labor and employment litigation. While there he won the high profile case of Westmoreland vs. Prince George's County where he represented an African American female firefighter who had been subjected to both racial and gender discrimination. In 2011 he took over as the firm's head of Middle East operations and spent the next three years advising the firm's clients in Turkey, Dubai and Abu Dhabi.

In early 2015 he returned to the public sector as the Supervisory Attorney of the D.C. Public Employee Relations Board. In this capacity, he oversees the legal operations of the Agency and litigates all cases in D.C. Courts where the Agency is a party.

Lindsey currently resides in Washington, D.C. with his wife, Dr. Letty E. Maxwell.
